CONTRACT

"Subscriber" in consideration of being supplied with water by the Town of Wesson Water Department, Wesson, MS, hereafter called the "Town", at the stated location or any other location, as hereinafter set forth, agrees to pay all bills rendered under prevailing rates for water and sewer services, hereafter referred to as "services", as established by Town Ordinance.

The Town will supply, as hereinafter provided, to subscriber must provide, free of charge to the Town, a place satisfactory to Town for a meter, subscriber will protect meter at all times and guarantee its return in good condition; subscriber will file with the Town a deposit as continuing security for the performance for all obligation, including the discharge of all debts for services rendered until notice is given by subscriber for discontinuance of said services.

Town will use all reasonable diligence within its power to provide uninterrupted service, but does not guarantee a constant supply, not the quality, not suitability of water, and will not be liable for any damage to persons or property caused either by a failure in constant supply, or by unsuitableness, or quality.

Town reserves the right to cancel this application and contract, and to refund the deposit of the cost to the Town of making connection should be excessive.

Failure by subscriber to promptly pay bills for services rendered by Town, under this contract at the stated location or elsewhere in the service district, shall terminate charges by disconnecting and disconnection meter upon reinstatement of services as set forth by Town Ordinance.

A \$15.00 penalty is added to any unpaid account after the 15th of the month. Accounts remaining unpaid after the 1st of the month will be disconnected. The full bill plus a \$75.00 reconnect fee is then required to reinstate. If necessary, the meter may be removed and the line capped. If this step is taken the full bill plus a \$250.00 fee to reconnect must be paid.

Failure by subscriber to apprise the Town of changes of mailing address may result in discontinuance of services by removal of the meter.

Reference is hereby made to Ordinances of the Town relative to water, sewer disposal as it copied in full herewith to which subscriber binds himself. Subscriber agrees to reimburse Town for reasonable costs of court and attorney's fees if compliance with Ordinance(s) is through the court system.

The subscriber agrees to follow the guidelines set forth by the State Department of Health regarding onsite wastewater disposal.

This contract contains all the terms of the agreement an no oral understandings are binding.
